I was looking forward to having a nice holiday this month, but it didn't quite seem to work out that way. But it never happened so here is a wrap of the golf in short.

Because I was not there on Sunday I can not really mention, Tony MacIsaacs air swing, Greg Breasley's 4x putts or the Supersized coach's obnoxious self promoting conversations. I can't discuss them because I didn't see them but just the same I could just about guarantee they all happened anyway.

Congratulations to Brendan Seagrave who has finally put a round together this year. Brendan has been receiving regular coaching tips from Big Mick during their weekly trip out to the Waterford Valley golf course.
