Centenary Park Results

Centenary Park is by far the best course that we will play on, this year, I think even with the tough conditions (Windy) and the shocking scores everyone still enjoyed the golf. Centenary Park will be a definite starter on the Sunday Leave Pass fixture for a long time to come. The club were very hospitable and put on a great BBQ after the game and the service was first rate.

"Interesting." That's one way to describe the golf this month. The first hole had an average of more than 9 shots per player and things didn't get much better from there. Lush, perfect fairways, smooth undulating greens, large water hazards and deep bunkers, the course offered a variety of different challenging holes including a 510meter Par 5 running straight into the teeth of a hailing gale force wind that you needed a rifle to hit through. There were more 10's scored than there were pars hit for the day, yet there was still the occasional flash of brilliance and the continuous sounds of hilarity.

Adam & Rick were the first players to arrive at the tee for a change, the rumour is that they camped in the car park at the course for the entire week after turning up a week too early. It's just a pity that Stu Coops didn't get a lift with his brother as he managed to get himself totally lost, Stu went from Forest Hill to Frankston via Berwick and weaved his way back along the only remaining gravel roads left in Melbourne. In fact the only time Stu spent on the correct road was when he hit his golf ball onto McLelland Road while playing the 4th hole.

Other noteworthy mentions include: Matt MacIssac who lost 3 balls on the first hole and at least 9 for the day. It was a very tough day our youngest member, as well as running out of golf balls during the round he came close to losing his entire golf bag and clubs when it took off in the very strong winds and crashed into a drain behind the 17th green.

Greg Parsons started the day thinking maybe I should have stayed in bed. It took him 6 shots to get past the ladies markers on the first hole, and also later during his round he had to spend 15 minutes raking the bunker after taking 5 shots to get out of it. He had dug more holes in the sand than his grade 4 class, did at a recent beachside school excursion.

Last years champion, armed with a brand new set of golf clubs imported all the way from China, managed to post his worst ever score since joining the club. It's not too late to sell them on Ebay Rick, you would still get a good price for them and you might be able to use the profit you make from selling them to buy some golf lessons.

Burnsie has retained as reputation as being the rebound king, he proved his prowess by hitting everything on the course except for a green. Burnsies, best shot struck the tree directly in front of him then ricocheted over his shoulder, bounced off another tree behind him and finished by rolling between his legs to a spot about 1 meter in front of where he played the shot from initially. That is talent.

Stu Coops played his round on 1x leg, with an injured ankle he really shouldn't have played except that he was too tight to cancel and still pay the \$30-00 for the round. Unfortunately our attendance levels have dropped off dramatically. After a great start to the year we are only getting a very small field to the course. Hopefully next month we will get a few more of the regularly faces back out there again.

In summary it was a fun day, the weather was good, the course was excellent and Gerard or Rick didn't win what better could you ask for.

Congratulations to Ron Parsons who used his new driver and new putter flawlessly to notch up his first victory. (Look out if he ever gets a new set of Golf clubs then there will be no stopping him. Maybe you could make an offer for Rick's as they didn't seem to work for him.) Ron was able to stay focused despite being surrounded by some terrible playing partners to win a close tussle with Darren Higgs on a count back. Both had scores of Nett 76 and scored 17 stableford points on the back nine however Ron won the countback with 3 points for his bogie on the par 5 on the15th hole that's the closest count back we have ever had.

Darren's 9 points for his 2nd place finish gives him a convincing lead on the championship leaderboard, especially given that his toughest rivals Daniel and Fitzy were both late withdrawls and didn't score any points. Adam Cooper finished in third position and our newcomers Wayne and Chris both aided by some very healthy handicaps using the Callaway scoring system were able to finish in 4th and 5th place respectively.
