SUNDAY LEAVE PASS CHANGES TO 2010 FORMAT

As from last Sunday we have introduced a few new innovations to the clubs activities.

*As a way of fundraising for the end of the year BBQ we have implemented a fine jar.

Historically, under the official rules of golf "when a player fails to hit the ball past the ladies markers he is obligated to buy a round of drinks for his playing partners." Unfortunately this rule was not being abided to. So it was decided that any player who fails to get passed the ladies tee's <u>MUST</u> pay a fine of \$5-00 into the 2010 fine jar immediately after the round.

Also players can be fined for

- 1. HAVING AN AIR SWING,
- 2. 4x PUTTING,
- 3. SHANKING.
- 4. THROWING A CLUB,
- 5. HITTING THE BALL ACROSS MORE THAN 1x FAIRWAY
- 6. Or any other act that the playing group deems should be a finable offence, which will be then put to the club for a vote.

Under the <u>Fine Jar 2010</u> legislation, all fines must be paid on the day and <u>a player can not be fined more</u> than \$10-00 irrespective of the number of indiscretions they may have had. A running tally will be posted on the home page of the Sunday Leave Pass Website once it is back up and running. A special thanks goes

to the 3x guys who failed to pass the ladies tee and Brendan for a 4x putt and therefore all contributed a fine to get the account up and going. I have also kicked in \$2-00 because my drive on the 12th missed the fairway by 2 holes.

Shank \$2-00

Any other act performed on the course which is deemed to be deserving of a fine can be put to the group for a vote after the game. \$2-00

Maximum pay out is \$10-00.

This year we have increased the championship points breakdown, as the club is growing in size and the monthly attendances are getting bigger. As of January 2010 we have decided to offer more points to the top end of the field. Last year we noticed it was becoming increasingly difficult to finish in the top 10 and guys who despite playing a pretty good round were missing out on the few extra points they deserved because they finished outside the top tier often only because of a countback.

We have now introduced a **Top 15**, with the **winner getting 15 points** towards the season championship, **2nd place** gets **14 points**, **3rd place** gets **13 points** and so on, until the **14th place** finisher is the recipient of **2 points** and anyone finishing from **15th spot to the beer wench position** will receive the standard **1 point** for showing up.

Once again, we will be running the skins competition and end of year raffle prize draw this year.

The way the skins competition works is that all members play off against the rest of the field on a hole by hole skins competition based on stableford points scored. If a player has a greater stableford score than everybody else in the competition then they win a skin and are therefore issued with a raffle ticket to go towards the end of year raffle. In the event that at least 2x people have the highest stableford score then the hole is jackpotted and the skin is carried over until such time as an individual hole winner is produced. Multiple skins are regular and very large jackpots are possible and extremely rewarding, since they give the winner a greater chance to win a major prize at the end of year raffle draw.

A raffle ticket is also issued to each player for every round of golf that the play through the season, and a bonus ticket is given if the player is wearing the Sunday Leave Pass club shirt.

Note: all handicaps are rounded to the nearest whole number. I.e. 17.2 = 17 handicap 17.5 = 18 Handicap

Over 2010 the AGU will be implementing a new handicapping system for golf clubs around Australia, so in order to comply with the new regulations over the next few months we will be changing over to the new **handicap format** as well.

If you are interested in finding out how the system works I have attached a link to the web site explaining the system,

But in summary, a players handicap is calculated by looking at the last 20 rounds of golf they have played, the scores are ranked from best to worst and the average of the sum of the players top 10 rounds X 0.96 is then used to formulate a starting handicap.

The player's handicap is then adjusted according to the difficulty and length of the golf course. The AGU are in the process of giving every course in Australia a difficulty course rating. The easiest golf course is **rated at 55**, an average golf course is **rated at 113**, and the most difficult of all courses can be **rated at up to 155**. When you are playing at a course your handicap will be altered according to it's difficulty, if it is a very hard course you will be rewarded with a few extra shots to play with or if you are playing an easier course like Ivanhoe, Ringwood or Glen Waverley the you might find your self playing on a lower handicap than you are used to playing off.

Under the new system a bad round could lead to your handicap changing by more than 0.1 at a time and the once in a life time dream come true score will not penalize you as harshly (since the changes will not be as significant) as it has in the past and you are less likely to be sent down to a handicap that you find impossible to play off.

There is still a lot of work to do to get this system operational and the info below may not yet be 100% correct but it hopefully gives you some idea what the outcome could possibly be.

NOTE: If any one has a firm grasp of the system and wants to help with the implementation and programming your help would be greatly appreciated.
