Warburton Results

It was a cold and early start but the promise of free food was enough to get a big field out to Warburton on Sunday. We finished up with 19 players even with 3x last minute cancellations. Winter has been good to us yet again and the early morning showers quickly disappeared and it turned out to be great day for golf.

As always Warburton claimed a few victims, scores of 10+ were pretty frequent but Fitzy's 15 on the last hole was the best of the lot of them. He lost 3 or 4 balls off the tee and had an air swing, which spoilt what may have otherwise been a pretty good back nine. I think the average score on the last hole was about 8 so he wasn't the only one who struggled to make it to the finish line. Shot of the day was a split decision between 2x players:

- ❖ Robbie smashed a shot which sailed 30 meters over the back of the green on the par 3 5th hole, which smashed ¾ up the middle of a tree trunk and Ricocheted back towards the green and nearly took out the NTP prize.
- ❖ Burnsy who couldn't find a person to hit as Young Matt and his mate Jess had stayed at home, managed to hit the ball into his own golf bag that was parked beside him.

There were a few good scores in as well, in fact only a few shots separated first to fifth places. Rick McEvoy came back into form after a bad round at Rosebud, he finished on top of the leader board, his round of 90 off the stick, which saw he him finish with a Nett 68. Rick one the day and his 10 points get him biting at the Heels of Daniel De Marinis who again featured high up points.

A special mention and a word of thanks, goes to Jamie, Greg and Ron Parsons who cooked the BBQ after the round. It was a bit disappointing when the facilities at

Warburton weren't working, especially after we had asked the Golf Course on 3 separate occasions whether they would be Ok to use. But the guys jumped in the car and found one that was working close by and they cooked up a real feast. It was just lucky Stu Coops didn't do the catering otherwise we'd all still be there trying to finish the last of the sausages that he proposed we would need.

It was great to have everyone stay around after the match for a bit of a catch up and a beer. Despite some pretty poor scores it sounded like everyone had a good time. Please be aware that we are regularly running into a problem with the beer kitty. Too regularly the bar runs short, Beers are \$2-00, this means you need to pay for them when you drink them. We don't want to, nor should we have to police the bar and have somebody collect the cash and serve the drinks. Surely we are all old enough to be able to deal with the honesty box system. This way there is less stress on the morning trying to chase the cash up from everyone, player attendance numbers will be easier to confirm and most importantly we don't have to walk around the golf course with hundreds of \$\$\$\$ cash in our wallets. Also by EFT banking Jamie doesn't have to deal with a debit on the credit card from some body still owes money because they didn't turn up to play on the day.

Handicaps

The handicapping system is adjusted monthly, dependent on the player's results. A poor round where a player scores worse than a Nett Par and their handicap goes out 0.1 shots on the other hand a good round and the handicap is reduced according to how much less than par they scored.

Until a player has played 3 rounds with the club they don't have an official handicap, however they are still eligible to win the competition and skins as their scores are calculated using the Callaway handicap system.

Congratulations to Ron Parsons who finally played his third round and earnt himself an official club handicap.
