

Glen scored Nett 75 using the Callaway handicapping system which earnt him 9 championship points.

Rick McEvoy came 3<sup>rd</sup> and won 5x skins with his Bogie on the 18<sup>th</sup> Hole. Stu Coops finished 4<sup>th</sup> and Daniel De Marinis extended his outright championship lead over Gerard with a 6 point, 5<sup>th</sup> place finish with a Nett 82.

#### Handicaps

The handicapping system is adjusted monthly, dependent on the player's results. A poor round where a player scores worse than a Nett Par and their handicap goes out 0.1 shots on the other hand a good round and the handicap is reduced according to how much less than par they scored.

Until a player has played 3 rounds with the club they don't have an official handicap, however they are still eligible to win the competition and skins as their scores are calculated using the Callaway handicap system.

Since everybody had a shocker all handicaps were adjusted by 0.1 shots.
