MOST IMPROVED PLAYER



This prize takes into account the player who is believed to have made the most significant improvement in their game over the duration of the year.

WORST IMPROVED PLAYER



This prize takes into account the player who is believed to have made the most significant downturn in their game over the duration of the year.

LEATHER WEDGE



The player who is best able to manipulate the rules of golf to help to improve their scorecard.

Actions such as kicking the ball out of the bushes with your foot when nobody looking. Not counting a short missed putt because you were only mucking around. Dropping another ball where yours was lost without taking the relevant penalties and creative accounting (just not counting all of your shots.)

ANGRY MAN AWARD

Marysville Golf Course Results

November

After an absolutely abysmal year of golf in 2014 by his standards, Gerard suddenly managed to find some good form for the serious tournament and he actually won the A grade 18 holes competition. Gerard won himself a new umbrella (might have been useful earlier in the day) and come very close to winning the A grade 27 holes competition as well.

Black Douglas also managed to take home a prize. Glen was the lucky winner in the Marysville golf club raffle and he won himself a bottle of port. Glen has turned his nose up at the prize, claiming that he only drinks the good stuff so Black Douglas has donated the prize back to the social club and we will be including it as a raffle prize on the end of year trip.

There are now only a couple of weeks left until the booze fest at Rich River and unfortunately there are still a few guys with outstanding accounts. We need to use the money outstanding to pay for the raffle prizes and the engraving of the Sunday Leave Pass player's choice awards trophies.

At 3am on Sunday morning it was not looking like we would even be hitting off the first tee. The rain on Saturday night and early Sunday morning was so heavy that it was looking like we were going to need a boat to find our way to Marysville. I congratulate all of the 16 guys who braved the unfavorable weather forecast (30mm rain and possible flash flooding) and made the hour and a half journey out to the Marysville golf course.

We were rewarded for our efforts with what turned out to be a very enjoyable day. The club put on a delicious lunch and the Marysville staff were all very accommodating and they did everything that was humanly possible to ensure that we enjoyed the day. The only thing they could have done to improve the day was ignore the big scores that appeared on some of our scorecards.

The hole which caused the most damage was the treacherous par 5 12th hole. The twelfth hole saw us all amass a total of 127 strokes at an average of nearly 8 shots per player. Rick, Larry and SOS all scored Newell's on the hole and another seven guys scored either an eight or nine. The worst score for the day however didn't come from a Sunday Leave Pass member but rather the captain of the Marysville golf club who recorded a total of 19 shots on the difficult par 5. He was actually hitting eleven off the tee before he managed to get a ball into play. Now that is dedication.

Stu Coops came close to mastering the twelfth hole. He hit a good drive and then knocked his second shot up and onto the side of the green. There could have been a realistic opportunity to make an eagle three or at least a tap in birdie on the most difficult hole on the course except for one major problem. Stu had done a Trevor Adair and played the wrong ball. Despite the ball having clearly identifying markings Stu had failed to realize that he was hitting Peter Hutsons golf ball and the end result was calling the penalty against himself, he then had to play the shot again with his ball (without the same level of success) and therefore losing the opportunity to have a Putt for the eagles nest prize pool. In the end Stu limped in the hole for a devastating nine instead of a three or four.

As is often the case his drive flew over the boundary fence and disappeared along the roadway. Almost every side of the ball been rubbed into the concrete and there were cuts and scratches all over it. Obviously the ball had landed on the road and then had been run over several times by passing trucks and cars.

Nigel finished in third place with a score of Nett 73 and Bryn was equal fourth but lost on a count-back to both Mick Harper and Peter Hutson who both had scores of Nett 75.

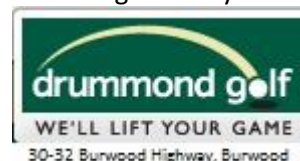
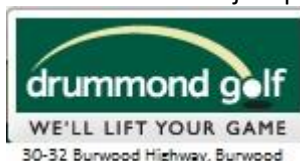
