# Ivanhoe Results



This months results saw the Big Fella coming through with an awesome round, he shot 78 off the stick with a triple bogie on the last hole, his Nett 61 was convincingly the best round for the day, which earnt him 10 championship points. Nick also won the longest drive and 7 skins, so it was a pretty good day all round.

Adam Cooper has continued to improve, he has followed up from his  $3^{rd}$  place finish at Albert Park with a  $2^{nd}$  place finish at Ivanhoe. Despite having nearly 1 ½ shots taken off his handicap this month Adam still finished his round 4 shots under par. Adam is now ranked  $3^{rd}$  and is only 4 points behind Daniel De Marinis.

Stu Coops played badly on the front 9, he shot 47 on the front, but improved when the sun came out, 36 on the back nine was good enough to get him into 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Daniel De Marinis shot a consistent round, 83 off the stick gave him a Nett 66, he came 4<sup>th</sup> overall and took the outright leaders position on the points tally. Gerard, Roger Powne and Luke Dumbrell all finished with sub par rounds.



It was great to see Luke Dumbrell back out and playing again, like Coups last month he had a sensational comeback game. Maybe there is something to taking an extended spell, it seems to improve the golf.

Remember that the more times that you play during the year, the greater the chance of winning a prize. For every month you play you are given a ticket for the end of year raffle draw. Being a raffle it gives everyone a fair chance of winning a prize and the regular players are rewarded because they have more tickets, so please make the effort to become a regular. Bonus tickets can be picked up along the way through the skins competition. Skins are calculated using the handicap system so anyone who has a good hole they could pick up a skin or two.

Skins were distributed to those players good enough to win a hole outright. If more than 1 player got the lowest score on a hole it is Jackpotted until an outright winner occurs.

#### Handicaps

The handicapping system is adjusted monthly, dependent on the players recent results. A poor round where a player scores worse than a Nett Par and their handicap goes out 0.1 shots on the other hand a good round and the handicap is reduced according to how much less than par they scored.

The use of duplicate score cards is working well. I know it is extra paperwork, however we are better able to decipher the handwriting and cross-reference any score inconsistencies. The scorecards have been more accurate since we implemented this system so we will continue to do it each month.

We are tracking each players Eclectic scorecard. This takes into account the best holes that they have for the year. We count only the best 4 scores that you get on Par 3's and Par 5's and the 10 lowest scores on a Par 4.

Eg. If on previous rounds you had scored 3,3,4,6, on the Par 3's and this month you got 4,5,5,3 then your score would come down to 3,3,3,4

Improvements are marked each month in green.

Next month we are playing at Rosebud at 11am, Rosebud is a very nice course, it is a lot longer and tougher course than some of the others that we have played but unfortunately the green fees are more expensive too. Please be aware that it will cost \$50 next month instead of the usual \$30.
