Ivanhoe Results

Daniel De Marinis shot a consistent round, 83 off the stick gave him a Nett 66, he came 4th overall and took the outright leaders position on the points tally. Gerard, Roger Powne and Luke Dumbrell all finished with sub par rounds.

Remember that the more times that you play during the year, the greater the chance of winning a prize. For every month you play you are given a ticket for the end of year raffle draw. Being a raffle it gives everyone a fair chance of winning a prize and the regular players are rewarded because they have more tickets, so please make the effort to become a regular. Bonus tickets can be picked up along the way through the skins competition. Skins are calculated using the handicap system so anyone who has a good hole they could pick up a skin or two.

Skins were distributed to those players good enough to win a hole outright. If more than 1 player got the lowest score on a hole it is Jackpotted until an outright winner occurs.

Handicaps

The handicapping system is adjusted monthly, dependent on the players recent results. A poor round where a player scores worse than a Nett Par and their handicap goes out 0.1 shots on the other hand a good round and the handicap is reduced according to how much less than par they scored.

The use of duplicate score cards is working well. I know it is extra paperwork, however we are better able to decipher the handwriting and cross-reference any score inconsistencies. The scorecards have been more accurate since we implemented this system so we will continue to do it each month.

We are tracking each players Eclectic scorecard. This takes into account the best holes that they have for the year. We count only the best 4 scores that you get on Par 3's and Par 5's and the 10 lowest scores on a Par 4.

Eg. If on previous rounds you had scored 3,3,4,6, on the Par 3's and this month you got 4,5,5,3 then your score would come down to 3,3,3,4
