When players finish with the same Nett score the points distribution and place rankings are calculated using a formula that takes into consideration the players score on the back nine holes, this compares the total Stableford points scored on the back nine and then works backwards from the 18th hole until an outright winner is found.

E.g. Rick and Roger both had a score of 68 and both scored 20 stableford points on the back nine, so but Rick scored 3 points on the 18th hole where as Roger only scored 2 points, therefore Rick finished with a higher ranking.

Note: all handicaps are rounded to the nearest whole number. **I.e. 17.2 = 17 handicap 17.5 = 18 Handicap**

On Sunday morning the Teams Ambrose competition was held and teams played off for the **Beer & Barocca Sheild**. The teams were decided by combining the lowest handicap player with the highest handicap player, 2nd lowest with second highest etc.

In Ambrose the players choose the ball that lands in the best position and then both members play from that position and keep doing so until the ball is in the hole. Each team member was required to contribute at least 6 drives each.
