

Waterford Valley Golf Course Results January

With the majority of the field wilting in the heat and the standard of play deteriorating towards the end of the day, it meant that some potentially great scores end up not so good. Under the new handicapping system the handicapper has been generous and offered some extra shots to quite a large proportion of the field. Interestingly Daniel DeMarinis who played 2x shots better than his handicap was even given a boosted handicap as one of his really good scores fell out of the top 20 scores. On the other hand poor Nick Brennan's handicap remains unchanged despite him finishing with a Nett 90, owing to only his top 2x scores being used to formulate his handicap. On the positive side for Nick his handicap is destined to go up to at

least 15.6 or more for his next round. The handicap predictor indicates that if Nick had played 20 rounds for the Social Club then his handicap would be frightening considering the glimpses of brilliance he showed on Sunday, but the numbers infer he could play of a handicap as high as 23 once his top 8 scores are factored into the equation.
