

Werribee Park Results

When players finish with the same Nett score the points distribution and place rankings are calculated using a formula that takes into consideration the players score on the back nine holes, this compares the total Stableford points scored on the back nine and then works backwards from the 18th hole until an outright winner is found.

E.g. Mark and Darren both had a Nett score of 70 and both scored 21 stableford points on the back nine, however Darren scored 3 points on the 18th hole with a par whereas Fitzzy had a bogey and scored 2 points, so Darren finished with the higher ranking.

Nearest to the pin prizes were won by:

Reminder

The ball must be clearly on the CUT surface of the green or fairway to win NTP or longest drive. If it is not on the fairway it doesn't count.

Each player won 1 ball each.

Dale was unlucky not to take out the longest drive he had smashed on long and straight drive down the middle of the fairway but he was knocked off by the last player of the day. Despite not winning the prize Dale was able to get a bit of a chuckle out of the fact that after hitting a 250 meter drive, PB took a further 8 shots to travel the next 150 meters.
