

Another great day on the Golf Course and good weather again, we have now played for 2 years without being washed out by bad conditions. It may be worth buying one or two for Gerard on Friday night of the golf trip as well, with the Saturday morning at Tocumwal being the last day for championship points, we need to somehow pull him out of his great form. Sunday's game was very close, Fitzzy played another great round, despite a 4 shot reduction of his handicap he still managed to score a nett 69. This was almost good enough to win, but unfortunately Gerard off a 16 handicap, hit 6x pars, 1x birdie and 7x bogies for 84 off the stick that was a 68 nett enough to earn him another 10 points.

On current form Fitzzy would be almost unbeatable if he ever learns to use his Putter, he had a four putt on the par 5, 6th hole after nearly being on for 2 big hits. With huge drives straight down the middle of most fairways and iron shots hitting the green in regulation it was only the 3 and 4 putts that let him down. With 9 points at Yarra Bend Fitzzy is the only other player left in the running for championship honours. He's only 7 behind Gerard so Saturdays game will be interesting. Maybe we should get them to play together to keep the pressure on.

Steve Powne and Matt MacIssac also played commendable rounds and came 3rd and 4th respectively. Double pars on the last 2 holes were the difference between Matt coming 1st and 4th he will be a really competitive force once he gets those few big blowout holes out of his game. Matt also had a couple of pars and a birdie and won the nearest to the pin on the 13th hole.

For those of you trying to work out the details of the golf trip and wanting to book golf carts (carts are already booked for the Sunday's round – at an extra cost for each player - \$17.50 each) the details are as follows:

We have booked 20 spots all have already been filled. Tony MacIssac is confirmed as a substitute for Deano Fitzpatrick. Deano we will be able to get your deposit back. (Lookout everyone it's another MacIssac, this is starting to sound like a mutiny.)

The total cost of the trip is \$200-00 everyone has paid a \$50 deposit. The balance is to be paid to Garry, Jamie or myself in the next week or so \$150-00 each. (Tony Mac \$200-00) – please don't make us chase you up! Very simply, just give one of us a call and organise to drop the money off.

The cost includes:
