Yarrambat Results

Season 2007 is looking like it is going to be a good one. In the first 3 months 23x players have made an appearance in the top 10. In previous years the same people (Daniel & Gerard) have dominated the top 10 but this year it seems that everyone is getting a chance at the top.

Once again we had a great turn out, 22x players fronted up to play, and all of them except for Adam Cooper managed to cope with the end of Daylight savings time difference. Unfortunately Adam thought you were meant to wind the clock back 2x hours instead of one and he only just made it into the car park as his group was hitting off the tee. After rushing to catch up with his playing partners Adam started off what turned out to be a very entertaining round of golf by skimming his first drive along the ground where it cannoned into the ladies marker, ricocheted 30 meters behind the tee and just missed a group of guys playing on the 9th hole. Adams playing partners were glad that he had made it to the course (even if he was late) since he had to shout the first 3x rounds of beers for not making it past the ladies markers on three separate occasions, after his amazing shot on the first hole to prove it wasn't a fluke he hit the ladies markers again on the 4th hole and then didn't make it to the squatters tee's again on the 9th hole.

Burnsie played a couple of extraordinary holes, on the Par 5, 7th he nearly took out the Eagles nest when his 7 iron hit from 150 meters out finished 2 inches from the hole. Burnsie hit his 3rd shot from out of a drain in the rough, the ball venturing 40 meters off line before it went around a huge gum tree then rolled side ways using

the contours of the land to find its way down onto the green, the ball then rolled between the legs of the players putting in the group ahead of him then stopped right next to the flag. (The ball was so close that it was a tap in birdie putt, which even Burnsie or Daniel DeMarinis couldn't miss.) Congratulations Burnsie on your first ever birdie.

On the very next hole (a short Par 3) Burnsie still pumped with adrenalin hit 3x balls into the lake and finished the hole with a 12, this brought him back to earth with a thump. The highlight was the shot that ricocheted off a 4mm wide signpost, nearly taking his head off, as the ball ducked into the lake some 25 meters behind where he had hit from in the first place. Much to the delight of the guys watching from the tee Burnsie then proceeded to hit his putt across the entire length of the green, the ball not only missed the hole bit it rolled off the other side of the green and back into the lake. Peter Bennett summed it up accurately when he said "Now that's what I call going from the **Penthouse to the Shithouse**."

From what was said after the game it sounds as though Matty MacIssac, Damijan and Greg Parsons who were all top 10 finishers last month never get out of the shithouse, and all finished at the back of the field.

Burnsie wasn't the only one to give the 28x ball Eagles Nest prize pool a real scare. Both Graeme Herft and Adam Cooper narrowly missed Eagle Putts and Daniel De Marinis had a chance for eagle but none of them were able to sink the putt. With all of those Eagle chances there turned out to be plenty of birdies carded, amazing there was 6 birdies scored which would have to be a club record.

The day however belonged to Rick McEvoy, he was very consistent around the entire course, and he was able to keep his concentration and stayed cool when his playing partners started to self-destruct around him. A score of 91 (Nett 72) earnt him 10 championship and the bragging rites over his mate Adam who, despite failing to hit past the ladies markers on 3x separate occasions still managed to finish with an impressive Nett 73 to take out 2nd place. What made Adams day so amazing was that he won 3x NTP holes, and had 7 pars and a birdie as well.

Daniel as always finished with a respectable round, in fact he probably should have won but 25 putts on the second 9 is an atrocious effort and deservedly it cost him a first place finish.

Brunto is make a strong bid to be the first player to go from "Worst improved" to win the "Most Improved player" in one year. He is the only player this year to have finished in the top 5 each month and consequently has secured his place at the top of the Championship leader board. Obviously the lessons and the regular Saturday practice rounds are starting to have an impact on his game.

Congratulations to Dean Fitzpatrick who finished in 5th place, he played a great round for a score of 106 that is a super effort considering he had to wipe off cobwebs and spiders nests from his golf clubs before he got them out of the car. Apparently it had been nearly 2 years since he'd played a round so to finish top 5 is a credit to him.
